Research Quiz Competition

Themes

The contest will test the following areas of research;

1. Literature review
2. Study Designs
3. Research methods
4. Sampling
5. Biostatistics (Descriptive & inferential)

General Rules

1. Only team entries are allowed.
1. All teams are required to prior register themselves online by **17th February, 2020**. Registration fee of Rs.500 per participant must be submitted on the day of the UMR Conference at the registration desk.
2. A team shall have 3 members.
3. All team members shall be undergraduates.
4. Every team shall have a team name and a leader.
5. Replacement of any participant of a team if inevitable shall be prior communicated via email or latest on day-one of the conference at the registration desk. Otherwise, it shall not be allowed.
6. Only the team leader shall answer a question.
7. The participants shall not be allowed to use mobile, any other electronic gadgets or consult the audience during the quiz.
8. Consultation within the team before giving the final answer shall be allowed.
9. The decision of the quiz panel shall be final.
10. Failure to comply with the rules may lead to disqualification or cancellation of marks (as per decisions of the quiz panel)

ROUNDS

Round 1: Elimination Round

1. Each team shall be asked a set of 3 questions. (Objective questions with options)
2. 10 points will be awarded for a correct answer.
3. There shall be no negative marking.
4. Answering time per question shall be one minute.
5. Team with least scores shall be eliminated.

Round 2: Buzzer Round

1. A question shall be posed to all teams and the team which presses the buzzer first shall be given the chance to answer.
2. 10 points shall be awarded for each correct answer.
3. 10 points shall be deducted for each wrong answer.
4. Answering time shall only be 30 seconds per question.

Round 3: Rapid Fire Round

1. Each team shall continually be asked questions for a minute.
2. 10 points shall be awarded for each correct answer.
3. There shall be no negative marking.
4. Participants need to answer the questions or say pass in order to move on to the next question.

In case of a tie between any two or more teams:

1. A question shall be posed to the remaining teams and the one which presses the buzzer first, answers.
2. 10 points shall be awarded for the correct answer.
3. 10 points shall be deducted, if the team can't answer or gives wrong answer.
